

Novocure® partners with Advarra® to support the Humanitarian Use Device (HUD) submission for Optune Lua™

Advarra is an independent IRB, with over 3,000 partner institutions nationwide

- Pursuing IRB approval through Advarra offers the potential for a quicker review, and seamless electronic submission
- Novocure will cover the fees for the HUD application IRB submission, review, and approval
 - *Novocure will pay these fees regardless of whether Advarra grants approval or not*

How to leverage Advarra for a HUD submission

STEP 1:

Contact your Novocure representative to confirm if your institution has an established partnership with Advarra

STEP 2:

Institutions with an Advarra partnership may begin registration and submission of the HUD application online at www.cirbi.net

Institutions without an Advarra partnership will need to establish a contract with Advarra. Your Novocure representative can provide information on next steps.

- Note: If you have a local IRB or Office of Human Research Protection, you will first need to notify them to complete any local requirements prior to submitting materials to Advarra
 - *If an institution has an IRB in place already, this IRB must first approve the use of Advarra*
